Two OJD eFiling Websites Available Until 2016 (Exact Date to be Announced)

Effective September 1, 2015 Google Chrome will no longer support websites that use Silverlight, including the current OJD eFiling website. To address this event, a new OJD eFiling website (HTML 5) that will accommodate Chrome users as well as Internet Explorer 11 and above, Firefox, and Safari, was launched on August 28, 2015. The “old” OJD eFiling website will remain temporarily active until 2016.

OJD eFiling allows filers to electronically file, serve, distribute, and deliver court documents in circuit courts that have gone live with the Oregon eCourt Case information system (OECIS) and eFiling. Filers can eFile 24 hours a day from home, office, or any other location. eFiling Kiosks are also available during regular business hours (M-F) in though courts that have implemented OECIS and eFiling.

New OJD eFiling Website Launched August 28th

On Friday, August 28, 2015 the Oregon Judicial Department and Tyler Technologies implemented a new eFiling website for users of OJD eFiling (Odyssey File and Serve). The new website (OJD eFiling HTML 5) allows users to file their cases and documents with the Oregon Circuit Courts without having to install Silverlight. Silverlight is a web plug-in used by the old OJD eFiling website (oregon.tylerhost.net). Users may now use the new website, or for backwards compatibility, may choose to continue to use the old eFiling website. The following document provides more information:

Users may continue to use the “old” OJD eFiling Website to eFile with the Oregon circuit courts during a transition period (ending in 2016) or may begin using the new version, OJD eFiling HTML 5. Filers can use either site to eFile documents with the Oregon circuit courts, but will only be able to continue using the Chrome browser with the new HTML 5 website – the “old” OJD eFiling website can still be accessed through Internet Explorer, Firefox, or Safari browsers.

New users coming onboard to OJD eFiling will be directed to the HTML 5 version of OJD eFiling.
